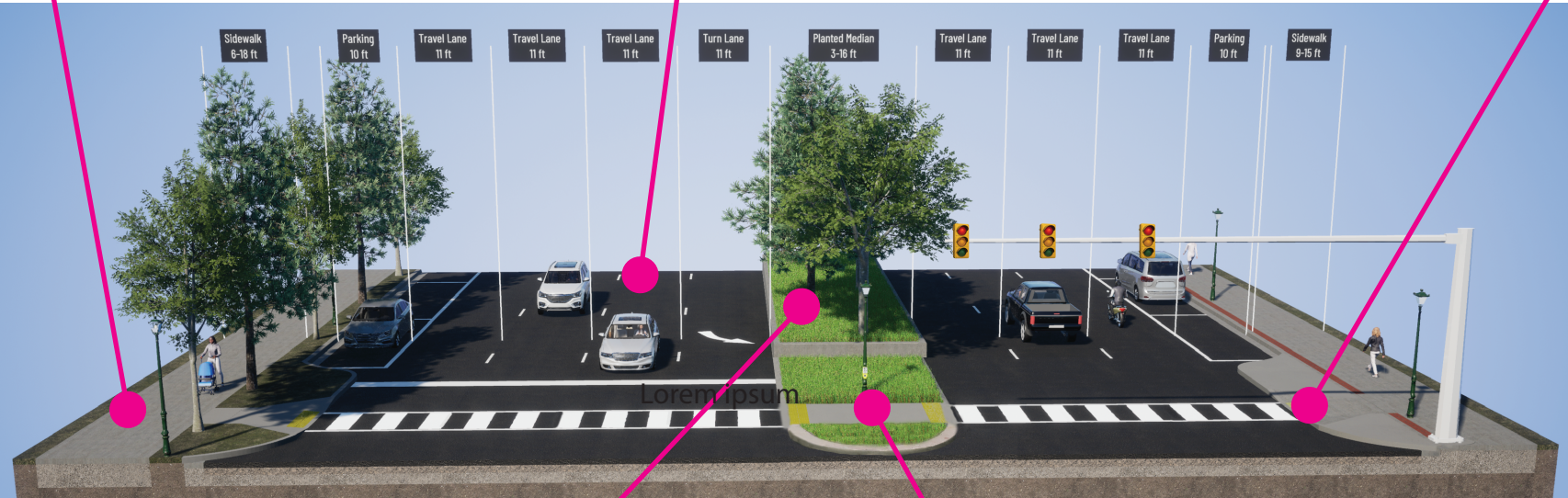

Project Description

The City of Columbia proposes to improve pedestrian and motorist safety along Assembly Street from Pendleton Street to Lady Street in downtown Columbia, South Carolina. The **Main Street/Vista District Connector** is being undertaken to improve pedestrian safety by improving pedestrian lighting, installing high-visibility crosswalks with curb bumpouts to reduce crossing distance, and adding traffic calming measures through landscaping and beautification elements. This safety improvement project is designed to enhance pedestrian facilities without affecting vehicular capacity.
